http://dev.fightingblindness.virtual.tibus.net/wp-content/uploads/2012/09/Fighting-Blindness He was diagnosed with retinitis pigmentosa, an inherited degenerative eye condition for which there is no treatment, in September 1994.

Very shortly after his diagnosis, he came into contact with Fighting Blindness, which was set up in 1983 as a support group by families affected by blindness. Tony worked on a consultancy basis for most of the late 1990s and into the early 2000s. In 2003, having previously worked with an organisation that had received EU funding for an employment initiative, he joined a company as a finance co-ordinator for an EU-funded programme in Ireland that diverted money to various projects.
